The Art of Summer provides youth (ages 9 - 12) and teens (ages 13 - 17) with an immersive exploration of the visual world and





Exhibit will be open from March 1st - 16th.

ArtMoves combines instruction in dance, music, and art to bring the life-enhancing benefits of creative expression to people with the least access to it. ArtMoves was developed by two longtime TDS teaching artists Pat Dolan and Lynn Fleischman from their own personal experience and training in multiple art forms.

Currently, ArtMoves works with men living in an emergency shelter, veterans dealing with serious mental illness, veterans living in long-term care, and refugee children. Classes are funded through a combination of individual and corporate gifts, public and private grants, and special events.
