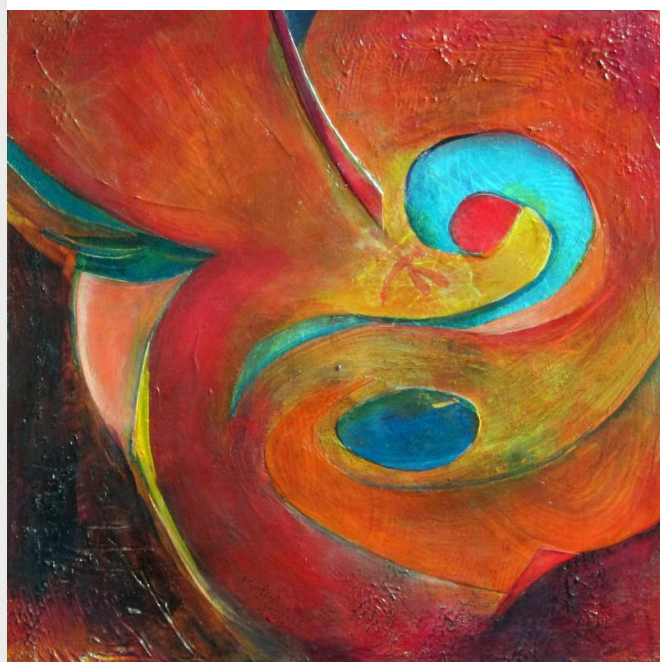


Student Exhibition & Pizza Party!

Expect to see and purchase fine, original artwork created by Drawing Studio faculty, members, and local artists, at affordable prices.

Participation is open to *all artists* residing in Tucson and surrounding areas. Artists may submit up to THREE original artworks ready to display salon-style in The Drawing Studio gallery (no reproductions, photographs, or giclees, please). **Maximum framed or cradled size should not exceed 12" x 12"**. 3D and sculptural works are welcome! All wall-hung work must be framed and/or equipped with ready-to-hang wire, cleats, or loop hanging devices. Artists may not withdraw accepted works before the exhibition closes.

No entry fee.

Please price artwork at \$200 or less: the artist/Drawing Studio split is 50/50. Donations above 50% are always welcome. Works sold may be taken immediately.
